POSITION SUMMARY:

A Master Diving and Salvage Instructor is required at Joint Expeditionary Base Ft. Story to assist with and consult to all aspects of diving readiness and training requirements. Conditions of employment include random urinalysis testing. The candidate must have knowledge and experience with and be able to assist with and/or consult to:

- Various dive and salvage techniques including USNS T-ARS/T-ATF Class ship operations
- Dive and salvage related publications including NWP, OPNAVINST, SUPSALV and MDSU specific capabilities including ROC/POE, CONOPS and NMETLS
- Managing instructor qualifications and certifications
- Classroom instructional support
- Design and evaluation of dive/salvage training exercises that includes / references Mission Scenario Events List and Joint Lessons Learned Information System
- Development and/or solution recommendations to MDSU tactics, techniques, and procedures and standard operating procedures
- Curriculum revisions/updates within Authoring Instructional Materials database and within CNET standards

MINIMUM REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Minimum of fifteen (15) years of operational diving and salvage experience.
- Navy Diver Qualification
- Instructor qualification or equivalent certification from a cognizant DoD Authority
- Dive Supervisor qualifications for scuba, MK-16, surface supplied air/HEO2
- Current Secret DoD security clearance
- Computer skills in MS Word, Excel, and PowerPoint.
